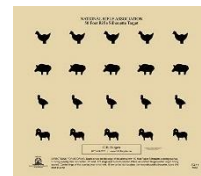




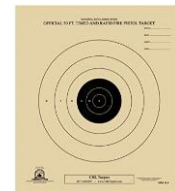
## 2026 FRCC WINTER INDOOR .22 RIFLE LEAGUE

The matches are open to the public at Flat River Conservation Club indoor 50-foot range 300 S. Greenville Rd. (East side of M-91). Any safe .22 rimfire or .22 air rifle can be used but no magnums. Starting Wednesday January 7 and running through March. Doors open at 6:30 p.m. with a 7:00 start. Warmup/sightin will be available. Each week is scored separately into the following divisions: scoped or irons, supported or offhand, air or cartridge. Results are sent via email or text. The cost is \$5 for members, \$10 for non-members.

**1st Wednesday of the month – Jan7, Feb4, Mar4:** Slow fire silhouette match on the NRA TQ-14 target. This target consists of 5 silhouettes of each of the 4 animals. We do 2 cards for a total of 40 shots. Offhand shooters need only touch any part of the animal with their shot to score a hit, whereas supported shooters need to hit clean...if any part of the shot is outside of the silhouette, then the shot scores as a miss.



**2nd Wednesday of the month – Jan14, Feb11, Mar11:** Rapid fire match using the NRA B-3 or B-3RC target. The match consists of 6 strings of 5 shots (two strings on each of three targets). Shot **offhand** starting from the low ready position (standing, rifle not in your shoulder). Semi-auto rifles get 10 seconds/string, any other action gets 20 seconds/string.



**3rd Wednesday of the month – Jan21, Feb18, Mar18:** Slow fire match on the NRA A-32 Light Rifle 6-bull target. The match consists of 5 shots on each of the scoring bulls plus unlimited sighters on the practice bull in 20 minutes. Meant to be shot **offhand** but supported is allowed.



**4th Wednesday of the month – Jan28, Feb25, Mar25:** Black Death Challenge. This match consists of 5 shots in 5 minutes, repeated 5 times with a new card for each string. Point values vary by size of the bull, but a mistake on any target can be costly.



**Rules:** Slings and/or rear rests are not allowed for support. Rifle cannot touch the bench (bare hand is OK). Only FRCC sand bag(s) may be used for a front rest. Mandatory: eye and ear protection, compliance with FRCC range rules and match director/RSO instructions.
